The Austin Seven Club Inc cordially invites you to compete at our 46th Historic Winton meeting, to be held Sat 27th & Sun 28th May 2023 at Winton Motor Raceway. Private practice sessions will be conducted on Friday 26th.

At Historic Winton "*our cars are the stars - the older the better*" and we continue to be fully dedicated towards the preservation and presentation of our early competition vehicles. Historic Winton is longest-running, all-historic race meeting in Australia with approximately 400 historic vehicles actively engaged in competition events. As Covid19 restrictions have eased, we expect another record entry list for both historic cars and motorbikes, and hope that you will again be part of the weekend's non-stop action.
